RRF stood beside the helpless and poor people to deal with COVID-19

Emergency Response

Rural Reconstruction Foundation has immediately made a move to fight against coronavirus after being reported case of COVID-19. Our primary task is to provide food aid to hungry people to deal with the initial crisis caused by the government declared lock-down.

Emergency food aid (Relief) has already been provided to 3,200 poor families in different parts of the country who are living helplessly in the coronavirus crisis. Families have been given a package of food for a minimum of 7 days. Beside, 140 sex workers have been provided food assistance for 7 days and each of them has been given a cash grant of BDT 200. All the staff working in the organization have been donated one day's basic salary for the month of April-2020 of BDT 3,07,730 to the relief fund of the Hon'ble Prime Minister. One lakh taka has been given to the Deputy Commissioner of Jashore on 02 June, 2020 as a corona treatment medical grant for those who cannot afford

Microfinance Program Enhancement

With the financial support of PKSF, RRF has provided stipend to the meritorious sons and daughters of the beneficiaries of it's Microfinance Program in the working area of the organization. A total 10 lakh 32 thousand Taka has been given as scholarship to 86 students who obtained at least GPA-4 in last SSC Exam 2019 and studying in Grade XII. Mainly the branch offices of the organization in Jashore, Meherpur, Chuadanga, Jhenidha, Kusthia, Khulna, Natore and Mymenshing districts under which the meritorious children of the beneficiaries have been considered for this program.

RRF is operating Formal and Non-Formal Education with its 8 formal School and 25 Pre-school. On the occasion of the death anniversary of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, various competitions have been organized with 1700 students of 8 Barnamala Bidyapith formal schools and 24 pre-school run by RRF. Due to the Corona epidemic, the school did not organize competition at school premises this time. The students participated in painting, story writing and essay writing competitions staying at their homes. Some have participated in this competition online. Prizes were distributed among the winners at the school on 15 August.

On September 24, 2020, Mr. Philip Biswas, Executive Director and Mr. Pinku Rita Biswas, Deputy Executive Director of the organization handed over the cars to the Assistant Directors in charge of Rajshahi and Meherpur Zones.

School Feeding Program Fortified Biscuits

Schools have been closed since March 16, 2020, after the onset of the Corona epidemic in Bangladesh. As per the decision of the Directorate of Primary Education, RRF is distributing biscuits to the students from door to door even during this emergency. In this case, the employees of the organization have continued their activities at the field level in compliance with the health rules. As of September 2020, RRF has distributed 1110 metric tons of biscuits to 189013 students in Jashore, Khulna, Narail and Bagerhat districts.

Inception of New Project



Rural Reconstruction Foundation has begun a new project titled "Pathways to Prosperity for Extremely Poor People" January 2020 as the Partner Organization of Pally Karma-Sahayak Foundation, the core implementing entity of the project. It is funded by the UK's Department for International Development (DFID) and the European Union (EU). Phase 1 has one-year inception period (1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020) and five-year implementation period (1 April 2020 to 31 March 2025) in Bagerhat, Khulna and Magura districts covering 7734 households.
