On this day in 1920, Bangabandhu, the undisputed leader of the Bangali nation, the architect of independent Bangladesh, and the greatest Bangali of all times, was born at Tungipara village of the then Gopalganj subdivision, now district. The staff of the organization in all field level offices of 23 districts including the head office of the organization celebrated the day in a joyous atmosphere by holding discussion meetings and cutting cakes. A mural of Bangabandhu is made and displayed at the head office of the organization which will be displayed till the Mujib-year celebration period.

School Feeding at Students' home



Due to the Corona crisis, all educational institutions have been closed since March 2020 and it is not possible to distribute high energy biscuits in schools. According to the decision of the Directorate of Primary Education, these fortified biscuits are being distributed to the students from door to door in the last few months. RRF, in partnership with the Directorate of Primary Education of the government, distributed 61 metric tons of biscuits to 202597 students of 1304 government primary schools in Jashore, Khulna, Narail and Bagerhat districts during the last January-March 2021 period.

Technical training is underway under the ASHSHASH project

In partnering with Winrock International RRF is implementing ASHSHASH projet in Jashore district which is funded by Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC). This Technical & Vocational training project provides Sewing Machine Operator, Tailoring & Dress Making, Mobile Phone Technician, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Electrical House Wiring Technician, Motor Cycle Mechanic, Consumer Electronics Technician and Driving trade. In recent time Mrs Dipta Rakshit, Team Leader, Ashshash Project, Winrock International and Md. Omar Faruk, Training and Employment Manager, ASHSHASH, Winrock International visited RRF training activities here in Jashore.





RRF participated in the Development fair

On the occasion of the transition from a underdeveloped country to a developing country, a development fair was organized at the government level on 26-27 March 2021. RRF participated in this fair held at Jessore Town Hall Field and showcased various activities of the organization for socioeconomic development. SEIP Technical Trainings Resume

After the closure of all technical training courses under the Skills for Employment Investment Program (SEIP) project from March 2020 due to the Corona pandemic, the trainings have resumed from January 2021. The courses started during January-March are IT Freelancing, Food and Beverage, Housekeeping, Mobile Phone Servicing, Auto Mechanics, Welding and Electrical Illustration and Maintenance courses. A total of 175 participants, 25 in each trade, are taking part in the course. RRF has been implementing this program since 2015 with the support of PKSF.

RRF Implement End Market Assessments for FtF Horticulture Activity in partnering with Chemonics International in different districts Jashore, Kushtia, Jhenidha, Khulna, Sathkhira, Bagerhat and Faridpur. Mainly, various workshops held with 280 number of different stakeholders related to mango, vegetable and banana cultivation. The main objective of this program is to find out the challenges of the concerned sub-sector and how to overcome these challenges.



RRF has arranged free cataract surgery for 46 elderly men and women of Gadaipur Union, Paikgachha Upazila of Khulna District on January 26, 2021 through an eye camp. This medical service was provided with the help of Khulna BNSB Eye Hospital under the ENRICH project. In addition, 315 locals received free eye care services at this eye camp.

FtF Horticulture Activity



RRF distributed sanitary napkins to 290 adolescent girls in Jashore, Bagerhat, Narail and Meherpur districts under the ongoing adolescent program with the support of Palli Karma-Shayak Foundation (PKSF) during the January-March 2021 period. In terms of developing intellectual thinking of adolescents and young people, this program creates health and nutrition awareness through adolescent health components and try to make sure the implementation various activities in practice. In addition, there are various interventions for the development of ethics and values, cultural and sports, and life skills.
